Chief Minister Vayoshree Yojana

1.25 lakh applications received

NASHIK: The Chief Minister Vayoshree Yojana designed to support senior citizens, has achieved a remarkable milestone in the Nashik division, receiving a total of 1.25 lakh applications. This scheme aims to assist individuals aged 65 and above by providing a one-time grant of Rs. 3,000, which can be utilized to purchase essential aids and equipment necessary for daily living and managing age-related disabilities.

Under the Vayoshree Yojana, eligible seniors can acquire various assistive devices tailored to their specific needs. These devices include glasses, hearing aids, walking aids, wheelchairs, commode chairs, and orthopedic supports such as knee braces and lumbar belts. This initiative not only aims to enhance the quality of life for the elderly but also encourages

their participation in mental health and wellness programs. Senior citizens are invited to engage in activities at registered yoga and training centres, which are integral to maintaining their overall well-being.

As of the end of July, only 17,468 applications across the Nashik division were received, with Jalgaon district leading with 15,600 application. However, in the following two months, there was a significant surge in applications, surpassing one lakh, thanks to proactive outreach efforts by the Social Welfare Department. These efforts include house-to-house surveys conducted under the "My Family is My Responsibility" campaign, aimed at identifying eligible beneficiaries and ensuring they are informed about the scheme's benefits.

The implementation of the

Vayoshree Yojana is coordinated at both municipal and district levels, with local officials overseeing the process. In urban areas, the scheme is managed through the office of the Municipal Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner of Social Welfare. In rural regions, the District Collector, along with the Assistant Commissioner of Social Welfare and the Committee of District Social Welfare Officers, ensures that the program effectively reaches its intended beneficiaries.

To qualify for the Chief Minister Vayoshree Yojana, senior citizens must turn 65 years of age by December 31, 2023, and possess a valid Aadhaar card. Interested individuals seeking more information about the Vayoshree Yojana are encouraged to contact the relevant municipal or district social welfare offices.

NASHIK: In celebration of Bramhotsav, a series of religious events will take place today, September 28, at the Shri Venkatesh Balaji temple, Kapad Peth, Nashik.

The festivities will begin with Shri Venkatesh Stavan from 9:00 am to 9:45 am, followed by Shri Venkatesh Prakatya Akhyana at 9:45 am. The much-anticipated Vimanotsav, along with Padyapuja and Aarti, will start at 10:00 am, and at 11:00 am, devotees can participate in Shri Venkatesh Sahastranam Tulsi Archana.

Shri Balaji Parivar has appealed to Nashikites to participate in these sacred events. The Balajiware Gharane (Family) has upheld this cherished tradition for last many decades. Vimanotsav marks the divine appearance of Lord Venkatesh on Bhadrpad Ekadashi, where the main idol of the lord is adorned in a swing decorated with flowers, accompanied by the idols of Sridevi and Bhudevi.

The emergence of Lord Venkatesh is celebrated with the blowing of conch shells, drum beats, and

tals (cymbals), creating a vibrant atmosphere. A traditional hymn composed by Timaiyya Maharaj, "Lavkar Hari Yave, Maj Pave, Sankat Sarva Harave," is sung during the celebrations.

After offerings to the lord, Aarti is held. The Bramhotsav continues from Ashwini Pratipada, where the deity is placed on various 'Vahans' (divine vehicles). The Mahotsav also features a variety of cultural and religious programmes, keeping the spiritual fervour alive throughout the event.
