Devyani Pharande scores hat-trick



NASHIK: BJP's sitting MLA Prof. Devyani Pharande has achieved a remarkable third consecutive victory in the Nashik Central Assembly constituency. In a high-stakes contest, she defeated Shiv Sena (Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray) group candidate and former MLA Vasant Gite by a margin of 17,856 votes. Pharande secured 1,05,689 votes, while Gite garnered 87,833 votes.

Pharande, who has represented Nashik Central for two consecutive terms, faced Gite, a former MLA who previously held the seat under the MNS banner in 2009. The two last contested against each other in 2014, when Pharande emerged victorious. This year's election

saw the rivals once again in a head-to-head battle, drawing significant public and political attention.

The vote counting took place at the Dadasaheb Gaikwad hall. Pharande established an early lead during postal ballot counting, which she carried forward into the 22 rounds of EVM counting. Except for five rounds, Pharande maintained her dominance throughout.

By the 12th round, she had already established a lead of over 10,000 votes, and despite expectations from Gite's supporters for a surge in the later rounds, Pharande extended her margin to 17,856 votes by the final count, sealing her historic third-term victory.

Seema Hiray secures hat-trick

NASHIK: Sitting MLA Seema Hiray has registered an hat-trick by securing her third consecutive victory in the Nashik West Assembly constituency.

Representing the BJP, she emerged victorious in a fiercely contested triangular battle, defeating her rivals with a commanding margin in the State Assembly elections.

Seema Hiray faced formidable competition from MNS candidate Dinkar Patil, a seasoned leader, and Sudhakar Badgujar, district president of the Shiv Sena (UBT group). Despite initial uncertainties, Hiray garnered overwhelming support from voters, especially women, with the Ladki Bahin Yojana said to have played a significant role in mobilizing female voters this year.

Hiray established an early lead in the first round of counting, though the margin was slim initially. By the 11th round, she crossed 50,000 votes, and by the 22nd round, she surpassed the 1 lakh mark. Her consistent performance widened the gap, culminating in a final tally of 1,41,724 votes. Sudhakar Badgujar and Dinkar Patil trailed significantly with 73,548 and 46,640 votes, respectively.

The presence of Dinkar Patil turned the expected two-way fight into a three-way contest, stirring speculation of a poten-

tial upset. The election was also seen as a symbolic clash between areas like Satpur and New Nashik. However, Hiray's unwavering popularity and robust campaign ultimately secured her a clear win.

Hiray's supporters celebrated her hat-trick victory with enthusiasm. Former corporator Madhuri Bolkar led celebrations, with party workers throwing gulal and beating drums outside

Hiray's office. Local leaders and supporters, including Ramhari Sambharao, Rajesh Darade, and Sanjay Raut, joined the festivities.

Sisters and brothers came forward to make me win. Especially women voters, who showed their trust. The Mahayuti has resolved several critical issues, including Cidco freehold and completing the Indiranagar swimming pool. In the coming term, I will focus on attracting industries and safeguarding workers' rights.

Rahul Dhikale retains Nashik East seat



NASHIK: BJP's Adv. Rahul Dhikale has secured a second consecutive term as MLA from the Nashik East Assembly constituency, defeating Ganesh Gite of the NCP Sharad Pawar group by a massive margin of 87,818 votes. With this victory, the BJP achieved a hat-trick in the constituency.

The counting of votes

began at 8 a.m. at the Meenatai Thackeray Divisional Sports Complex in Panchavati. Dhikale established an early lead during the postal vote count and maintained his advantage throughout all 24 rounds of counting. By the end, Dhikale had garnered 1,56,246 votes, while Gite trailed significantly with 67,429 votes.

This is the defeat of money power and the triumph of people's power. I am grateful for the blessings of my beloved sisters and for the votes I received for the development work I've done. Saroj Ahire secures 2nd win

NASHIK: Saroj Ahire, the sitting MLA from the Devlali Assembly constituency and candidate of the NCP Ajit Pawar group, has emerged victorious for the second consecutive term. With a decisive margin of 40,679 votes, Ahire solidified her position as the leader of the constituency, reaffirming Devlali as a stronghold of the NCP Ajit Pawar faction.

The Devlali Assembly constituency had been the focal point of intense speculation and political maneuvering. Initially, there was uncertainty about which faction of the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) would field a candidate. While the NCP Sharad Pawar group was expected to contest the seat, it was ultimately allocated to the Shiv Sena Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray (UBT) group, with Yogesh Gholap chosen as the candidate. On the other hand, the Shiv Sena Shinde faction fielded Rajashri Ahirrao, though later disowning her as the official candidate.

The counting of votes began on November 23 at Sayyad Pimpri. Although Yogesh Gholap initially led during the postal ballot count, Saroj Ahire quickly gained ground once the EVM vote counting started. She maintained a consistent lead across all 20 rounds, ultimately securing 81,683 votes.

Rajashri Ahirrao, despite being unofficially disowned by the Shinde faction, outperformed Gholap by securing 41,004 votes, leaving him in third place with 39,027 votes.
